2016 SUMMER CAMP TRIP DESCRIPTIONS ALL GRADES

*Trips are listed alphabetically. All trips are pre-paid before camp begins. Trips are on a first come-first serve basis. There **is no** exchanging of trips with other camp participants. Please note which trips where food is included, and which trips have either an early drop-off or late return time.*

Breakwater Beach (4th – 8th Graders) - \$32.00

A state-of-the-art water park with one of the largest interactive play area on the North Atlantic Coast. The renovation of **Jenkinson's Breakwater Beach Water park at Casino Pier** (Formally Water Works) offers campers a fun and exciting family attraction. Pizza, Chips and a Drink will be provided.

Build a Bear (K-3rd Graders) - \$20.00

Participants will go to the Freehold Raceway Mall. Here, everyone is empowered to imagine, and every bear begins a story. Building a furry friend is building so much more. Bear and an outfit are included in the price. Campers can bring their lunch or purchase lunch at the food court.

2016 CAMPER DISCIPLINE POLICY

The Department of Recreation and Senior Services reserves the right to impose any discipline, up to and including expulsion from camp. All disciplinary actions will be documented and filed. The following are examples of misconduct that will lead to written warnings and/or phone calls home, suspension, and/or expulsion from camp program;

A. Abusive/Profane Language – any abusive and/or profane language used towards other campers or staff members

- 1st Offense – Phone call home to parent/guardian
- 2nd Offense – One (1) day suspension
- 3rd Offense – Three (3) day suspension
- 4th Offense – Expulsion from camp

B. Defiance/Disrespect/Disruptive/Disobedient towards staff

- 1st Offense – Phone call home to parent/guardian
- 2nd Offense – One (1) day suspension
- 3rd Offense – Three (3) day suspension
- 4th Offense – Expulsion from camp

C. Failure to follow camp rules and regulations

- 1st Offense – Phone call home to parent/guardian
- 2nd Offense – One (1) day suspension
- 3rd Offense – Three (3) day suspension
- 4th Offense – Expulsion from camp

D. Horseplay – endangering the welfare of yourself or others

- 1st Offense – Phone call home to parent/guardian
- 2nd Offense – One (1) day suspension
- 3rd Offense – Three (3) day suspension
- 4th Offense – Expulsion from camp

E. In Unauthorized Area

- 1st Offense – Phone call home to parent/guardian
- 2nd Offense – One (1) day suspension

- H. Physical Assault/Verbal Threat – of any kind toward any persons
1st Offense – Phone call home and five (5) day suspension
2nd Offense – Expulsion from camp
- I. Inciting remarks of a Racial, Religious, Ethic Nature, Harassment, Intimidation, and/or Bullying
1st Offense – Expulsion from camp
Incident will be immediately reviewed and addressed by the Director and Jackson Police Department
- J. Harassment of any kind
1st Offense – Phone call home one (1) Day Suspension
2nd Offense – Three (3) Day Suspension
3rd Offense – Expulsion from camp
- K. Sexual Harassment
1st Offense – Phone call home and Expulsion from camp
- L. Theft – anything taken from school, department, or others
1st Offense – Phone call home and five (5) Day Suspension
2nd Offense – Expulsion from camp
- M. Vandalism – intentional or repeated abuse or destruction of property
1st Offense – Phone call home and five (5) Day Suspension
2nd Offense – Expulsion from camp
- N. Participation in a Food Fight
1st Offense – Phone call home and three (3) Day Suspension
2nd Offense – Expulsion from camp

 1st Offense – Phone call home and three (3) Day Suspension
 2nd Offense – Expulsion from camp
- P. Weapons – of any kind
 1st Offense – Expulsion from camp
- Q. Pulling Fire Alarm/Bomb Threat
 1st Offense – Phone call home and Expulsion from camp
 Incident will be immediately reviewed and addressed by the Director and Jackson Police Department
- R. Bus Misconduct of any kind; Standing while bus is in motion, moving from seat to seat, fighting, putting hands on another camper, putting hands out the window, defacing any part of the bus, not listening to leader or counselor, etc.
 1st Offense – Phone call home to parent/guardian
 2nd Offense – One (1) day suspension
 3rd Offense – Three (3) day suspension
 4th Offense – Expulsion from camp
