## 2017 SUMMER CAMP TRIP DESCRIPTIONS K-6TH GRADES

*Trips are listed alphabetically. All trips are pre-paid before camp begins. Trips are on a first come-first serve basis. There **is no** exchanging of trips with other camp participants.
