MISSED RECYCLING

If you forget to put it out or were late in placing recycling items out, this is not considered missed recycling. You may wait to the next pick up or bring it to:

**Recycling center at (Compose Station) 40 Don Connor Blvd.
HRS: Fri-Tues 8AM to 3:30 PM.
Closed on Wednesday and Thursday.**

Residents may have up to 7 containers each 45 Gal or less W/LID and recycling stickers on them. Township does not provide with cans. You can use any color can as far as it is 45 gal or less. You can pick up the stickers at DPW building, Clerk's and Tax collectors offices.

If you place your recycling out the night before your scheduled date or prior to 6:00 AM and the truck passes it without a pick up, leave it curbside and call **Central Jersey Waste at (609) 771-8005.**

Keep in mind to follow the recycling guidelines as to what

you may place in your recycling containers. If you place items that are not acceptable, your containers will be deemed "Contaminated" and will not be pick up. If your scheduled recycling pick up day falls on a Holiday, the recycling pick up is pushed forward a day.

Household Hazardous Waste and Paper Shedding

This service is provided by the Ocean County Division of Solid Waste Management and is scheduled by Ocean County. If you would like to be notified of the County schedule, please register online for email notification at www.co.ocean.nj.us/solidwaste.

Bulk Waste & Brush Pick Up

Curbside Bulk Waste may be placed at the curb up to 48 hours before your scheduled pick up. Residents should place items neatly and piles should be no larger than 4 foot by 4 foot by 8 feet in length.

Dark plastic bags are not acceptable. Hazardous items and construction debris may not be placed curbside. Small pieces of broken toys, household garbage, broken glass, etc. should be placed in your regular garbage.

Accepted Items are:

- Furniture
- Appliances
- Carpeting
- Bedding
- Pool covers
- Metal

These items must be generated by the homeowner. Bulk waste pick up is not for cleaning out an entire house by a landlord.

Guidelines for scheduled Curbside bulk.

Bulk Waste: Neatly placed curbside 24 hours prior to the scheduled pick up date and not to exceed a 4'X4'X8' pile. Bulk piles must be accessible and mattresses and cushions must be covered.

Brush: Placed loose along curb in accessible piles.

During Bulk Waste Pick Up, the Township will not take:

- Electronics
- Things in Cardboard Boxes
 - Construction Debris
 - Hazardous Waste
 - Plastic Bags
 - Paint, ECT

Construction Debris Voucher

Each Household is entitled to two (2) construction debris vouchers per year, (no fee for vouchers). Proof of residency is required! Vouchers are for the purpose of disposing of remaining construction debris from a house project such as: wood, doors, windows, sheet rock, roofing, sidings, fencing, tub, toilet, tiles, sink, cabinets and carpet.

You can also reach out to Public Works Department and the form will be emailed or mailed to you. If you still have additional debris, you may go to the Ocean County landfill located at 2498 Route 70, Manchester NJ. There is a fee to dispose of the waste/debris. Landfill is closed Sunday.

Transfer station is only open for Jackson residents. Residents Means residing In the Home.

Items accepted include: Furniture, Mattress and/or Box Spring, Tables, Chairs, Lawn Mower (no fluid inside) carpet, Washer, Dryer, Fridge/Freezer (doors removed), Exercise Equip, Used Motor Oil (5 gal)

Electronics: TVs, Computers, Printers, Monitors, Fax Machine.

Recycling: Commingled recycling items

Rigid Plastics: Kiddies Sandbox, Kitchen, Grill, Slides, Log Cabin etc...

No Commercial Vehicles of any type will be permitted on the site.

Limit three (3) trips per day. 6'X8' or smaller Trailers only. Cardboard must be broken down to 3' X 3' all packaging materials removed. Hover board batteries must be removed and ready for inspection. You will be rejected with black bags. You may remove the matter from the bags and return to the site. Two (2) forms of acceptable "ID", Divers License or Tax Bill only. You must be in the vehicle if dumping at

this site. This site is not for emptying a home. You must hire a Dumpster from a company to empty your home.

Compost Station Guidelines

We do not accept grass clippings of any kind. No stumps or logs accepted. All brush must be in 4 feet lengths or less and no more than 6 inches in diameter.

No commercial vehicles (plates, markings or signage) will be permitted to enter this site.

No contractors are permitted. Any vehicle entering this facility must be registered in New Jersey. Identification must be presented for proof of Residency.
